	2. Turn right onto Trinity Blvd. <i>Trinity Blvd is 0.1 miles past Chittamwood Blvd</i> <i>If you are on Robert Trent Jones Pky and reach Callaway Dr you've gone about 0.1 miles too far</i>	2.2 mi
	3. Turn left onto East Lake Rd N.	7.0 mi
	4. East Lake Rd N becomes McMullen Booth Rd.	5.0 mi
	5. Turn right onto Union St. <i>Union St is 0.1 miles past Lake Cypress Dr</i> <i>If you reach Harbor Oaks Cir you've gone about 0.1 miles too far</i>	0.8 mi
	6. Take the 3rd right onto Soule Rd. ☐ <i>Soule Rd is 0.2 miles past Wings Way</i> ☐ <i>If you reach 2nd St E you've gone about 0.1 miles too far</i>	0.3 mi
	7. 2201 SOULE RD is on the right. ☐ <i>Your destination is just past Chancery Ln</i> ☐ <i>Your destination is at the end of Soule Rd</i>
