Driving directions to Sand Hill Scout Reservation

26 miles – about 45 mins

1. Head **north out of parking lot** toward **Cypress Lakes Blvd** 43 ft
2. Turn right at **Cypress Lakes Blvd** 13.1 mi
Turn left at light and follow **Little Rd**
3. Turn RIGHT onto US-19 N. 9.9 mi
4. Turn RIGHT onto CORTEZ BLVD/FL- 2.3 mi
50 E.
5. End at 11210 Cortez Blvd Brooksville, FL 34613-5401
6. The location is on Hwy. 50 West at the Sand Hill Scout
Reservation (across from Oak Hill Hospital).
