	3. SR-54 E becomes SR-56 E.Map	0.9 mi 20.0 mi total
	4. Merge onto I-75 N via the ramp on the left toward Ocala.Map If you reach Silver Maple Pky you've gone about 0.4 miles too far	76.9 mi 96.9 mi total
	5. Take the US-27 S exit, EXIT 354, toward Ocala / US-301 / US-441 / Silver SPGS..Map	0.4 mi 97.2 mi total
	6. Turn right onto NW Blitchton Rd / US-27 S / SR-500 S. Continue to follow US-27 S / SR-500 S.Map	2.8 mi 100.0 mi total
	7. Turn left onto US-441 N / US-301 N / NW Pine Ave / SR-25 N / SR-200 N. Continue to follow US-441 N / US-301 N / SR-25 N / SR-200 N.Map US-441 N is just past NW 6th Ave	9.9 mi 109.9 mi total
	8. Keep right at the fork to go on US-301 N.Map	70.2 mi 180.1 mi total
	9. Merge onto I-10 E via the ramp on the left toward Jacksonville.Map	12.9 mi 192.9 mi total
	10. Take the I-295 Beltway exit, EXIT 356, toward Savannah / Daytona Bch.Map	0.1 mi 193.1 mi total
	11. Merge onto I-295 N via the exit on the left toward Savannah / Int'l Airport.Map	14.9 mi 207.9 mi total
	12. Merge onto I-95 N via EXIT 35B on the left toward Int'l Airport / Savannah (Passing through Georgia, then crossing into South Carolina).Map	218.7 mi 426.7 mi total
	13. Merge onto I-26 W via EXIT 86B toward Columbia.Map	52.6 mi 479.3 mi total
	14. Merge onto I-77 N via EXIT 116 toward Charlotte (Crossing into North Carolina).Map	93.3 mi 572.6 mi total

5. Turn left onto NC-89 W / W Pine St.  3.8 mi
101.3 mi total



6. Proceed to 266 RAVEN KNOB RD.
