1. Head **east** on **Co Rd 1/Little Rd** 407 ft
2. Take the 1st **right** to stay on **Co Rd 1/Little Rd**
Continue to follow Little Rd 1.5 mi
3. Turn **left** at **FL-54 E** 17.5 mi
4. Continue onto **FL-56 E** 0.7 mi
5. Merge onto **I-75 S** via the ramp to **Tampa** 14.1 mi
6. Take exit **261** to merge onto **I-4 E** toward **Orlando** 53.5 mi
7. Slight **right** at **Florida 417 Toll N** (signs for **Disney World Celebration/FL-417 N**) 0.5 mi
8. Take the exit toward **Disney World** 0.3 mi
9. Merge onto **World Dr** 6.1 mi
10. Continue straight to stay on **World Dr** 1.0 mi
11. Turn **right** at **Timberline Dr** 0.3 mi
12. Take the 1st **right** onto **W Wilderness Rd** 0.9 mi
13. Turn **right** at **Fort Wilderness Trail**
Destination will be on the left 0.3 mi
