Slight left onto FL-200 Ross Prairie Campground will be on the right 6.0 mi

FRIDAY - ARRIVE, SETUP CAMP

We will park and pick up tubes at Rainbow Springs State Park located at 10830 S.W. 180th Ave Rd, Dunnellon, FL 34432, which is located on the east side of the river. From the park we will ride the tram up river and then float back to our point of origin. We will leave our vehicles at the state park. The float trip is approximately two hours long. After floating down the river we can show our receipts for free admission to the headsprings area of the park at the US 41 entrance for a day of swimming and exploring. We also have the opportunity to re-float the river at no additional cost.

Things To Expect:

- The Rainbow River is 72 degrees year-round.
- The floating trip will last about 2 hours.

- While enjoying the natural surroundings please be mindful to the riverbed, it is very important to protect the ecosystem of the river.
- The River may be swift in some areas.
- The walkway when you exit the river is slippery.
- The depth of the water varies throughout the river.
- Please try to get over to the left side of the river early and use the rope provided to exit the river.
