## **MAP FROM TRINITY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF SEVEN SPRINGS TO THE GREEN SWAMP WEST TRACT**

Take I-4 West to US Highway 27

South toward Cypress Gardens and Lake Wales

Stay on US-Highway 27 to SR-60 in Lake Wales

Take SR-60 East for 6 miles past Lake Wales

Turn Left onto Boy Scout Camp Road for about 1.5 miles

Turn Left at the Flaming Arrow Scout Reservation sign

OR

1. Start out going south on Little Rd/County Hwy-1 toward Saint Lawrence Dr.  
Then 1.44 miles
2. Turn left onto State Road 54/FL-54.  
Then 17.56 miles
3. Stay straight to go onto State Road 56/FL-56.  
Then 0.73 miles
4. Merge onto I-75 S toward St Petersburg.  
Then 1.38 miles
5. Keep left to take I-75 S toward Naples.  
Then 12.62 miles
6. Merge onto I-4 E via EXIT 261 toward Orlando.  
Then 18.44 miles
7. Merge onto FL-570 E/Polk Pkwy E via EXIT 27 toward Lakeland/Winter Haven (Portions toll).  
Then 9.87 miles
8. Take the US-98 exit, EXIT 10, toward Bartow/Lakeland.  
Then 0.42 miles
9. Merge onto US-98 E/FL-35/FL-700 toward Bartow/USF/PCC.  
Then 7.51 miles
10. Turn left onto Van Fleet Dr/US-98 E/FL-60/FL-700. Continue to follow Van Fleet Dr/US-98 E/FL-60.
  1. Van Fleet Dr is 0.3 miles past Manor Dr
  2. If you reach Blount St you've gone about 0.1 miles too farThen 0.51 miles
11. Turn right onto State Road 60 E/FL-60.
  1. State Road 60 E is 0.3 miles past N Wilson AveThen 24.49 miles
12. Turn left onto Boy Scout Rd.

1. Boy Scout Rd is 0.5 miles past Orion Ln
2. If you reach R J Keene Rd you've gone about 1 mile too far

Then 1.27 miles

13. 1201 Boy Scout Rd, Lake Wales, FL 33898-9224, 1201 BOY SCOUT RD is on the left.

1. Your destination is just past Flaming Arrow Rd
2. If you reach Roy Keen Rd you've gone about 1 mile too far
