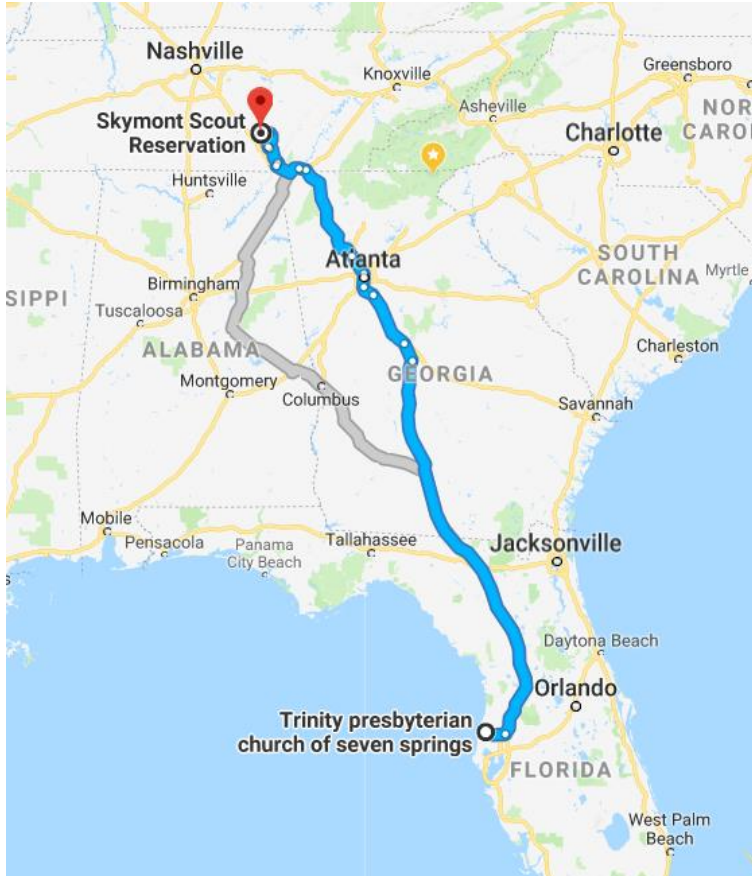

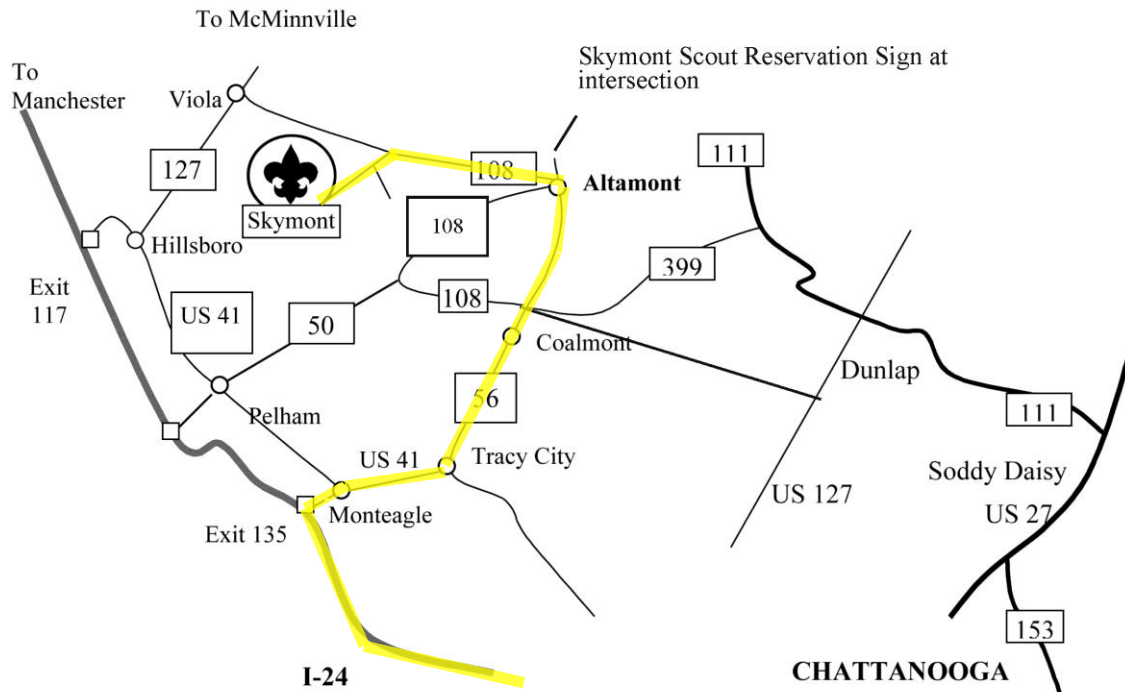

The camp is located at GPS Coordinates 35 25.57N 85 51.45W

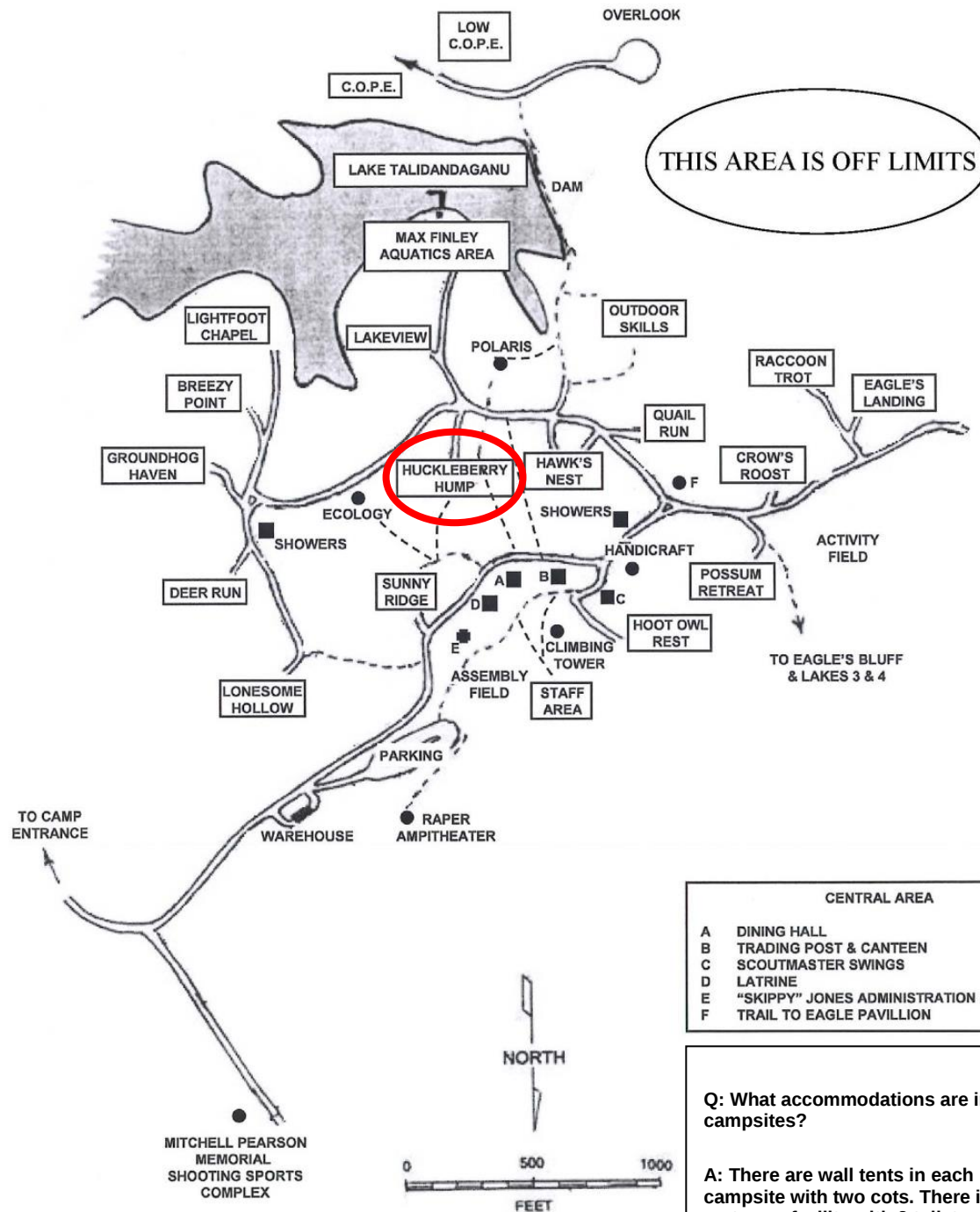


From Chattanooga: I-24 West to Exit 135 – Monteagle. Turn right and go approximately 1 mile, turn right onto US Hwy 41 to Tracy City. In Tracy City, turn left on Tennessee Hwy 56. Travel on TN Hwy 56 through Coalmont into Altamont. In Altamont, turn left on Tennessee Hwy 108 - N (Tri-County Bank and Skymont sign at this T-intersection). Go approximately 7 miles on TN Hwy 108 - N, turn left on Cabbage Patch Road at sign for Skymont Scout Reservation (small saw mill on right before turn). Bear right at fork, Skymont camp entrance about 3 miles on right.

There are several 108 intersections in Altamont. If coming from Chattanooga or Knoxville turn at the 3rd 108 "T" intersection. There will be a Skymont Scout Reservation sign at the intersection.

SCOUT MEALS:

Meals while at camp are provided by Skymont Scout Reservation.

Scouts will need money for meals/snacks on the way to and home from camp

Saturday 6/16 - morning eat breakfast before departure

Saturday 6/16 - Lunch and Dinner – **\$20-\$30** should be enough for the day for most.

Camp Technically does not start until Sunday afternoon. The Scouts will need money for Breakfast (most likely Donuts/Juice) and Lunch (probably hotdogs/hamburgers). **\$10**. Money should be given to ASM purchasing food. Food will be purchased at the last town on the way into camp.

Saturday 6/23 - morning Eat breakfast at camp before departure

Saturday 6/23 – Lunch (on the road) and Dinner (picked up and brought to cabin) – **\$20-\$30** should be enough for the day for most.

Sunday 6/24 - Breakfast and Lunch – should be home before dinner - **\$10** should be enough for most.

SITE CLEANUP – Pick Up & Discard any Trash in the Camp Site. Bring full trash bags to the dumpster area.

FIRE – Gather firewood and start fires. Care for and refuel. Put out fire.

WATER – Get drinking water and all water needed for any fires.

WAITERS – Assigned Patrol is to head to Dining Hall 20 minutes before any meal to help the staff prepare for the meal.

LAUNDRY – Two ASMs will take everyone's laundry to a local laundromat on Tuesday or Wednesday.
