
DIRECTIONS:

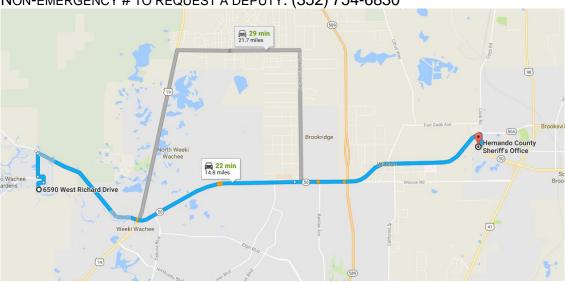

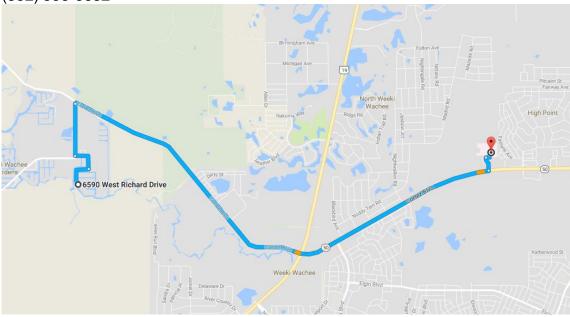

- River Rules
 - Life Jackets MUST be worn on ANY Watercraft.
 - You are NOT permitted to touch, feed, molest or ride the manatee.
 - You may kayak/swim next to them and observe.
 - When using a motor boat, there is NO wake law. Keep boat speeds slow enough that no wake is created.
