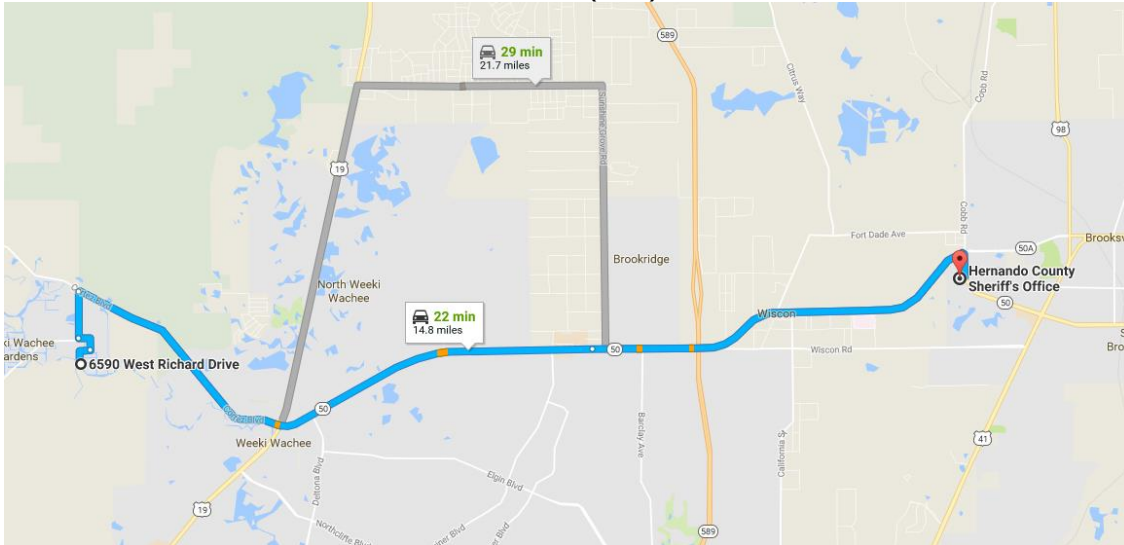

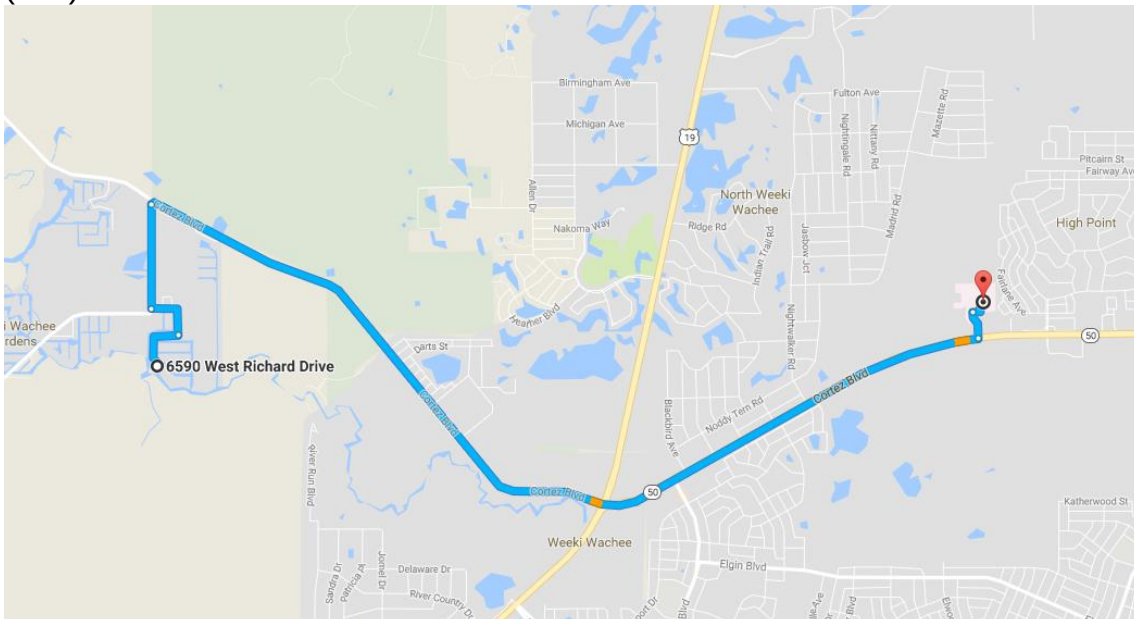

- River Rules
 - o Life Jackets **MUST** be worn on **ANY** Watercraft.
 - o You are **NOT** permitted to touch, feed, molest or ride the manatee.
 - o You may kayak/swim next to them and observe.
 - o When using a motor boat, there is NO wake law. Keep boat speeds slow enough that no wake is created.
 - o

Wildlife may include alligators, snakes, turtles, manatees & otters. **DO NOT** approach, touch, or feed any of the wildlife. It is against the law.

SITE CLEANUP – Pick Up & Discard any trash in the camp site.

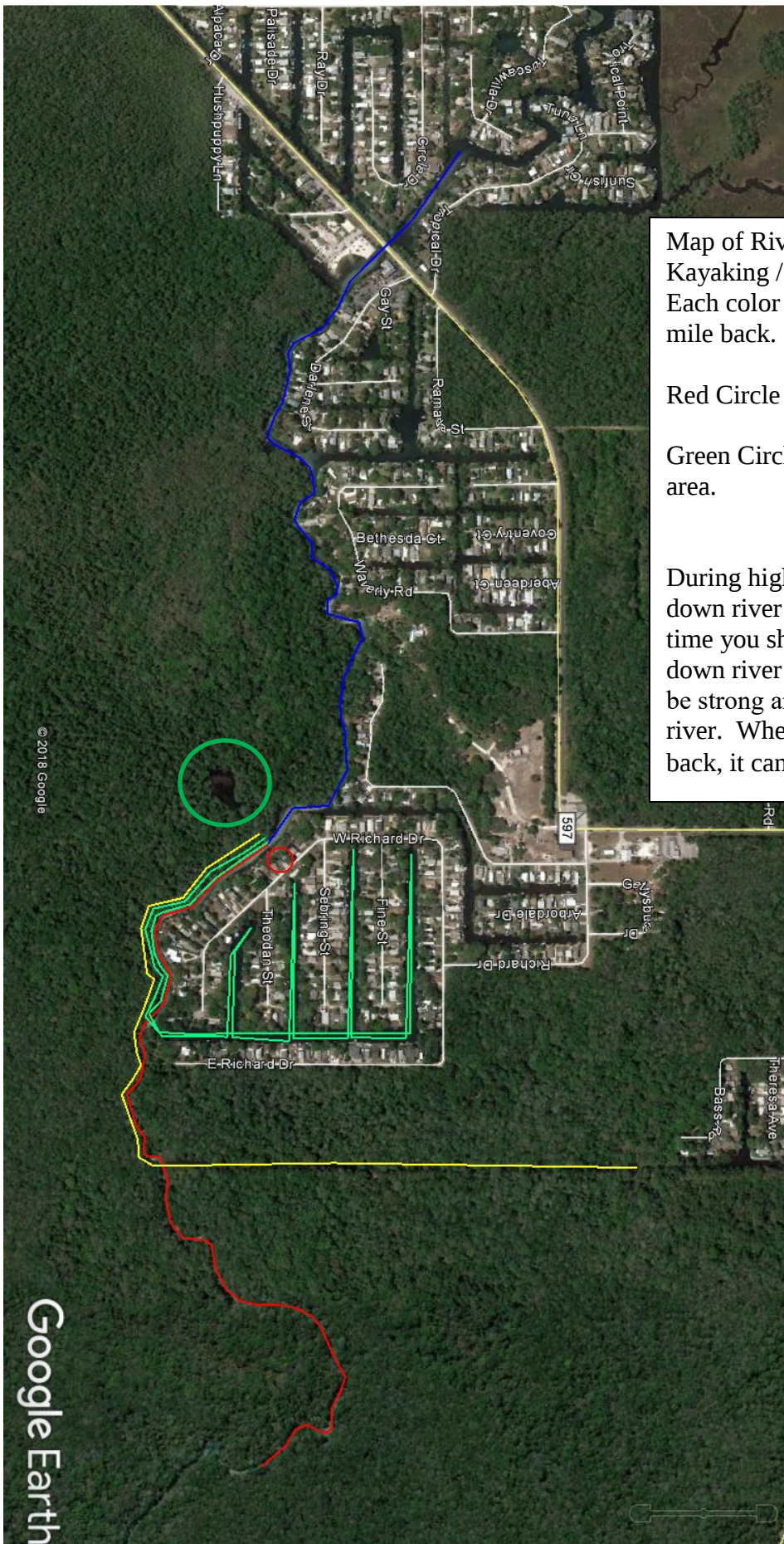
FIRE – Gather firewood and start fires. Care for and refuel. Put out fire.

Map of River showing potential Kayaking / Motor boating treks. Each color is one mile up and one mile back.

Red Circle – Camp

Green Circle – motorboating practice area.

During high/slack tide you may go down river (blue line). Any other time you should go up river. Going down river at low tide, the river can be strong and it's easy to go down river. When you turn around to come back, it can be Very difficult.
