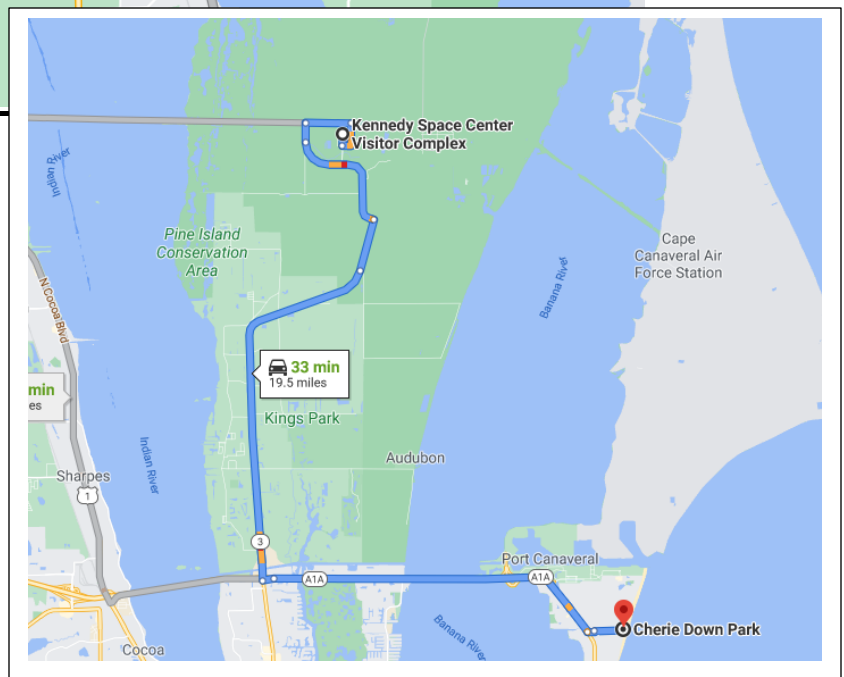

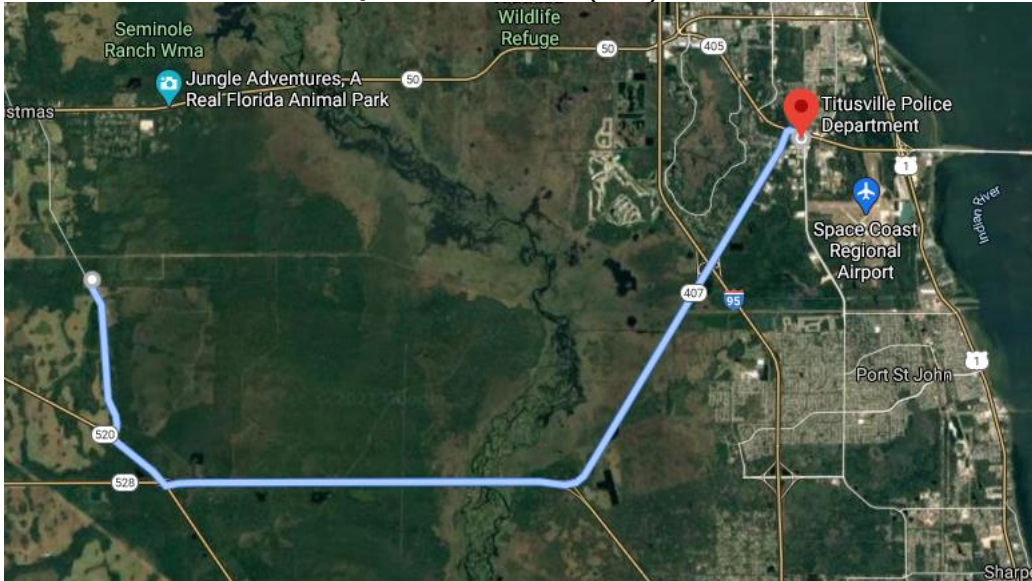

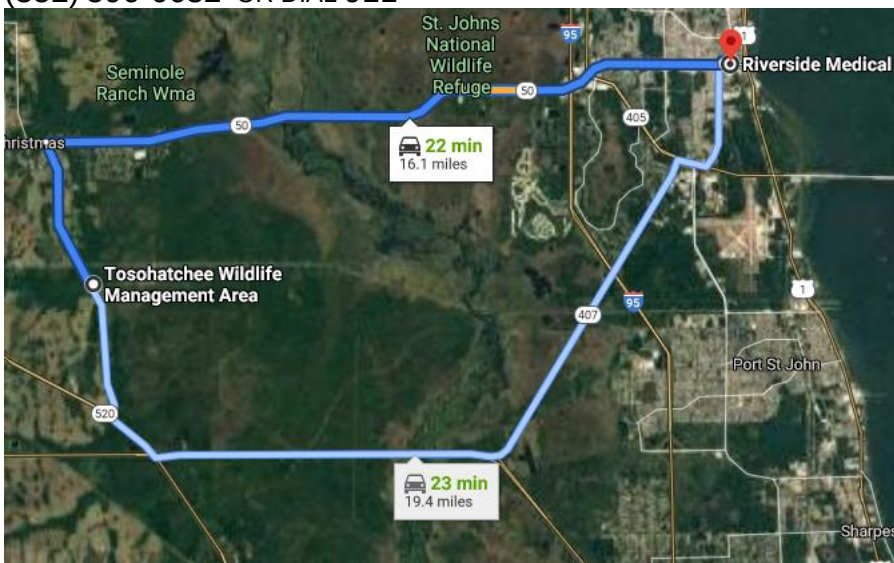

CONDITIONS TO BE AWARE OF:

- **All** – Fires must be in designated fire pits only.
- **HYDRATION**- Remember to bring one gallon and drink plenty of water throughout the day.
- **DO NOT** approach, touch, or feed any of the wildlife. It is against the law.
- **April** is typically can be **rainy** in FL, warm in the day and cool at night. Remember this when packing.
- **BUGS** – Bring bug spray, mosquito net if sensitive to insect bites.
