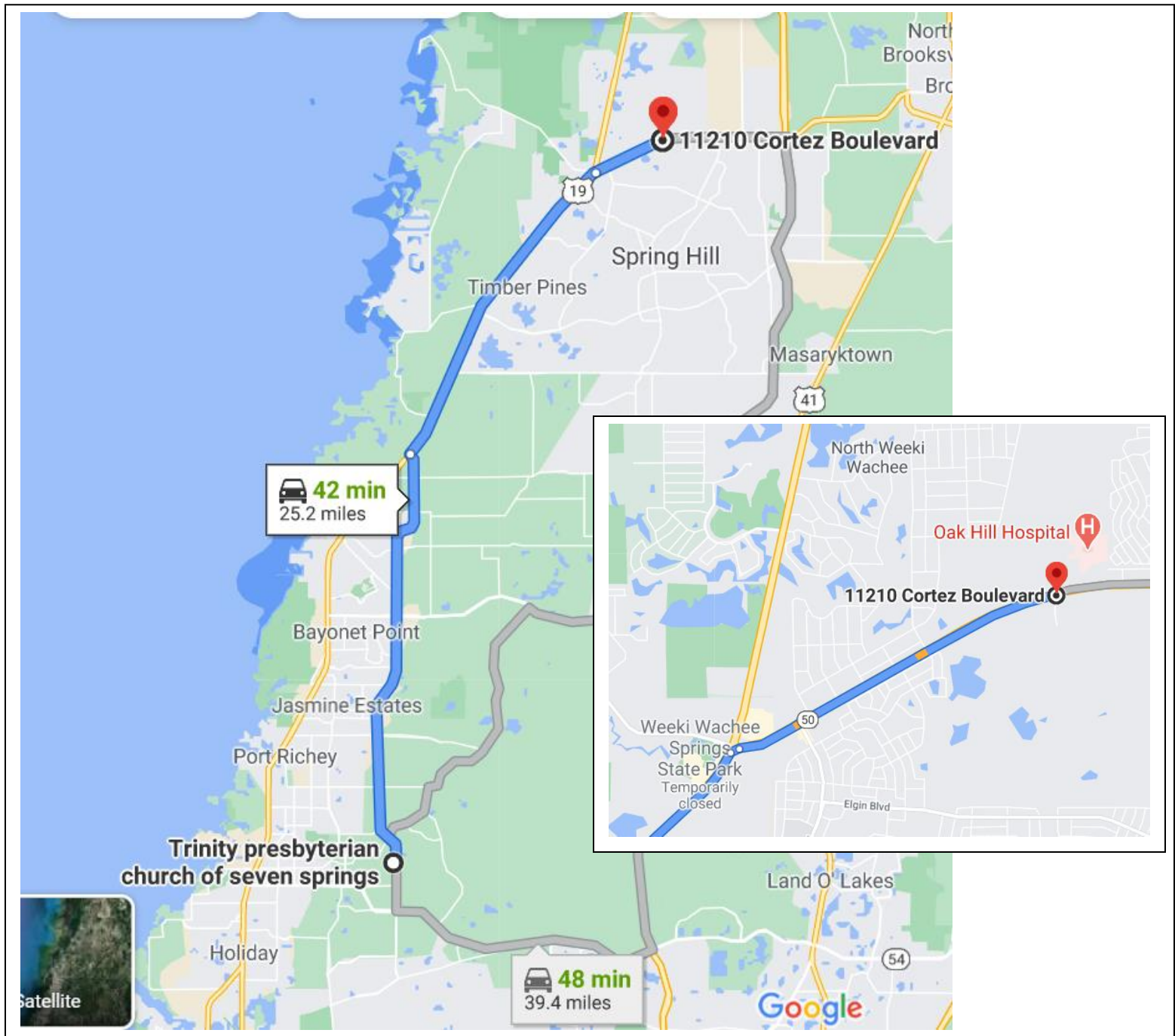

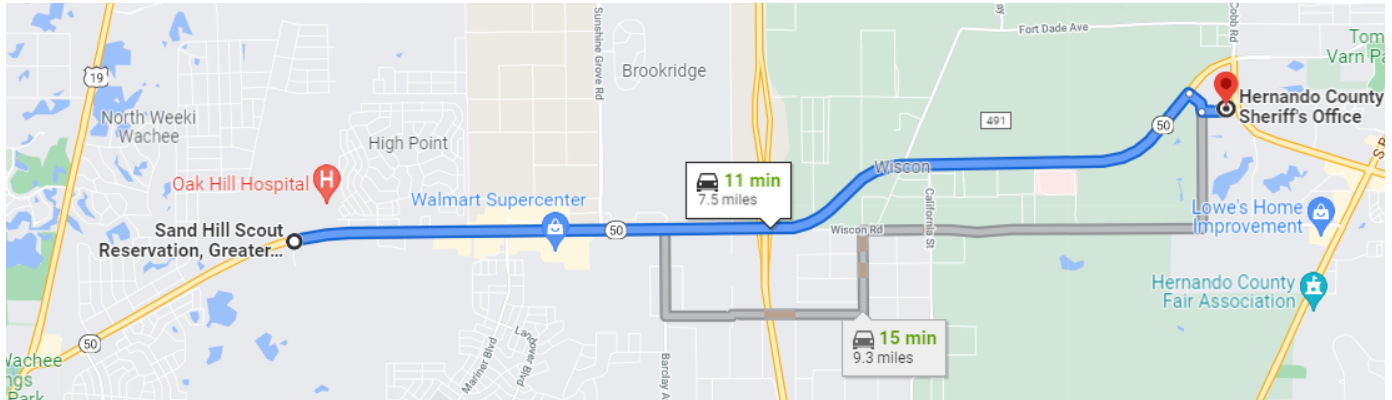

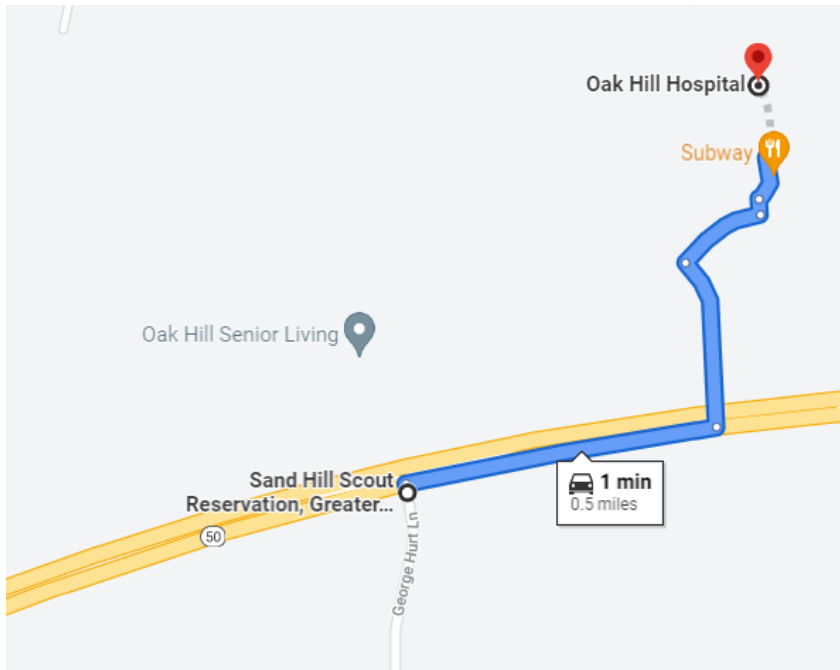

TENT ASSIGNMENTS: -

GTBAC CURRENT RULES ARE THAT TENTS CAN BE USED AT 50% LABELLED CAPACITY. IE, A “4-PERSON TENT” CAN HAVE TWO SCOUTS.

If weather is nice, scouts can also sleep under the stars / in hammocks.

CONDITIONS TO BE AWARE OF:

- **All** – Fires must be in designated fire pits only.
- **HYDRATION**- Remember to drink plenty of water throughout the day.
- **DO NOT** approach, touch, or feed any of the wildlife. It is against the law.
- **September** is typically can be **rainy** in FL, hot in the day and cool at night. Remember this when packing.
- **BUGS** – Bring bug spray, mosquito net if sensitive to insect bites.

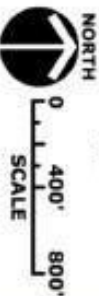

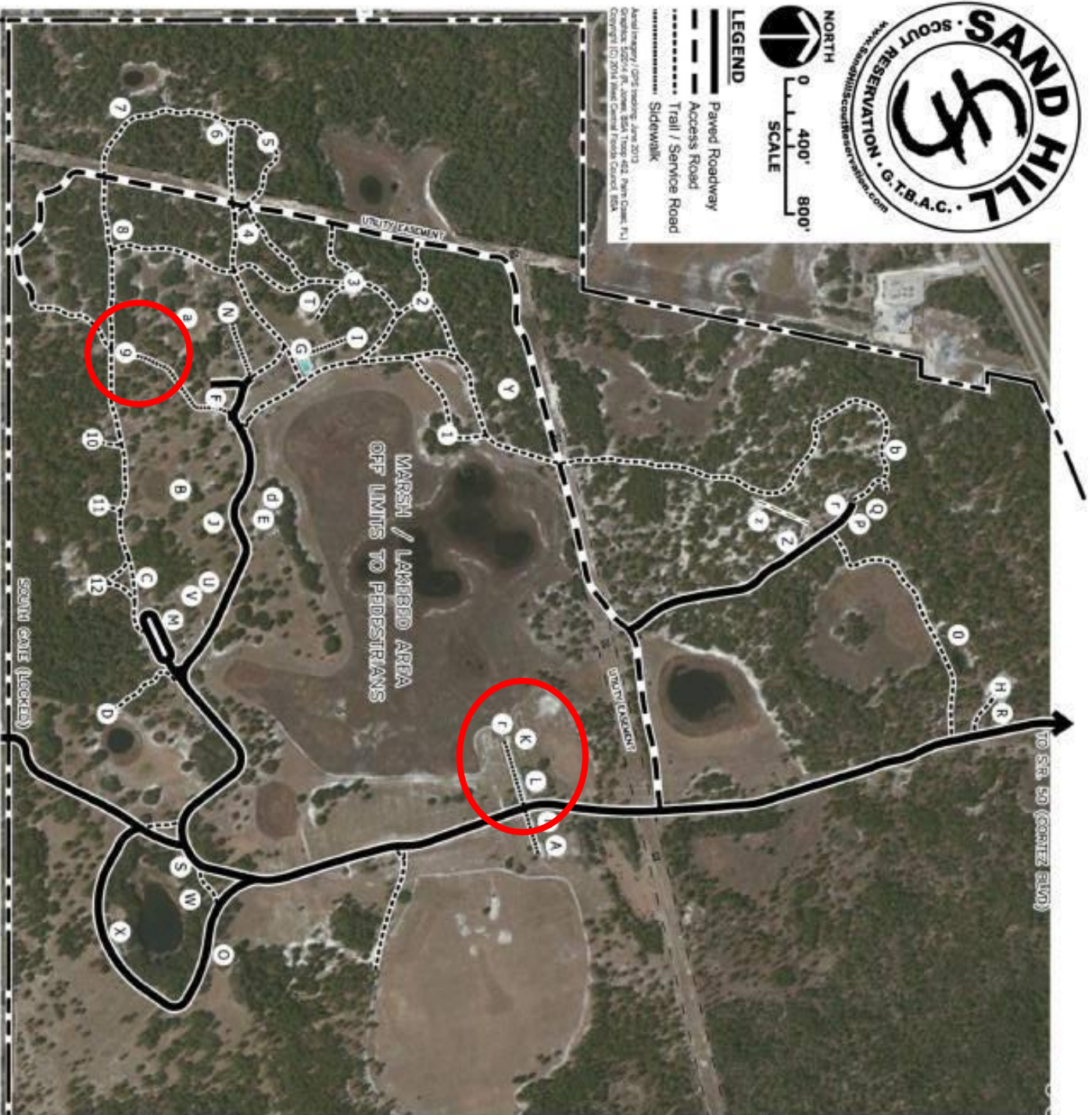
