TENT ASSIGNMENTS:

- SCOUTS MAY BRING THEIR OWN TENT, OUR USE TROOP TENTS AS AVAILABLE.
There is a large group attending, so scouts borrowing tents may need to double up.
No more than 2 years (720 calendar days) between tent buddies.
- IF WEATHER IS NICE, SCOUTS CAN ALSO SLEEP UNDER THE STARS / IN HAMMOCKS. There looks to be a good tree line against the edge of the campsite. Also potential to use trees that have been taken down to build tripods to hang hammocks from.

CONDITIONS TO BE AWARE OF:

- ○ **All** – Fire must be in fire pit.
- ○ **HYDRATION**- Remember to drink plenty of water throughout the day.
- ○ **DO NOT** approach, touch, or feed any of the wildlife. It is against the law.
- ○ **BUGS** – Bring bug spray, mosquito net if sensitive to insect bites.
- ○ **GATORS** – There is a small pond at the campground. Small gators have been seen in it from time to time.
- ○ **DEER** – There may be Deer on the property.
- ○ **BATHROOMS** – Port-a-John Being Delivered to the site. We will also be at the Aquarium much of the Day Saturday and there are Restrooms there.
- ○ **WATER** – We will have our large water containers filled with water. We are close to areas to get additional water if needed. There is a water meter on site we will also attempt to hook into.
