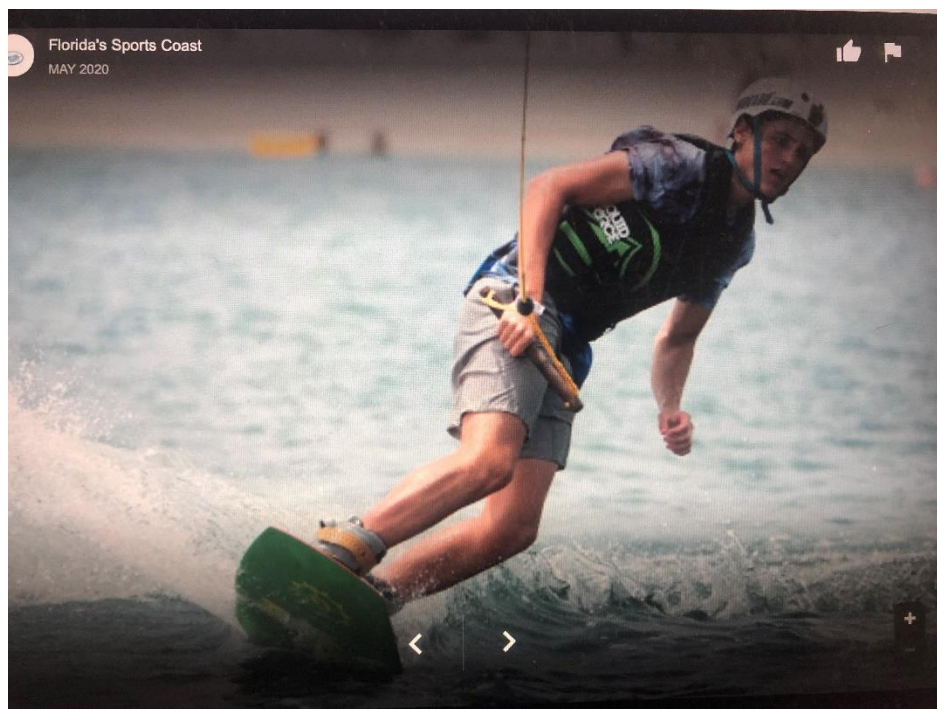
TENT ASSIGNMENTS:

- SCOUTS MAY BRING THEIR OWN TENT, OUR USE TROOP TENTS AS AVAILABLE.
There is a large group attending, so scouts borrowing tents may need to double up.
No more than 2 years (720 calendar days) between tent buddies.

Those Working on Wilderness Survival will need to make their shelter Saturday and sleep in it Saturday night.

CONDITIONS TO BE AWARE OF:

- ○ **All** – Fire must be in fire pit.
- ○ **HYDRATION** - Remember to drink plenty of water throughout the day.
- ○ **DO NOT** approach, touch, or feed any of the wildlife. It is against the law.
- ○ **BUGS** – Bring bug spray, mosquito net if sensitive to insect bites.
- ○ **GATORS** – There is always the potential for gators in Florida waterways.
- ○ **BEAR** – Bears have been seen in the region.
- ○ **BATHROOMS** – Bathhouse is available a short (1/2 mile) walk from the campsite.
- ○ **WATER** – Water is available at the Bathhouse. We will also have our large water containers filled with water. And will fill them as needed.
