



Living Room: 3 Couches


House has 2 full bathrooms inside, and one outside. There is also an outdoor shower outside.

# **CONDITIONS TO BE AWARE OF:**

- River Rules
  - Life Jackets <u>MUST</u> be worn on <u>ANY</u> Watercraft. This is BSA Policy.
  - You are <u>NOT</u> permitted to touch, feed, molest or ride the manatee.
  - You may kayak/swim next to them and observe.
  - When using a motor boat, there is NO wake law. Keep boat speeds slow enough that no wake is created.
