





TROOP GAMES RULES:

- 3 patrols, plus 1 adult patrol.
- AOLs will randomly be joined with patrols.
- Not every scout has to play every sport.
- Every scout does need to participate in some events.
- Fielded teams need to have equal numbers of players on the field. Teams may have subs.

Outside Games:

- Soccer (half field): 5-7/side (equal patrols) plus subs
 - o All Teams play each other. 4 teams = 6 games
 - o 2 games played at the same time.
 - o 15 minute games (+/- 1 hour total)
- Flag Football (Short field): 5-7/side (equal patrols) plus subs
 - o All Teams play each other. 4 teams = 6 games
 - o 2 games played at the same time.
 - o 15 minute games (+/- 1 hour total)
- 4 Square (squares are on outside basketball courts).
 - o Patrol chooses 8 scouts to play.
 - o AOL scouts are their own patrol, adults don't play in this game.
 - o Patrol members play themselves in two games. Both winners move on to play against the other patrols. (4 patrols x 2 winners each = 8 players moving on)
 - o 2 games, each game has 1 from each patrol. Each game will have a 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th for points.
 - o Rules/scoring in place ahead of time
 - o (+/- 30 minutes total)

Inside:

- Basketball: 4-6/side
 - o All Teams play each other.
 - o Games to 21 (must win by 2pts) or 15 minutes.
- Volleyball: 4-6/side
 - o All Teams play each other.
 - o Games to 11 (must win by 2pts) or 15 minutes.
- Tug of War 5 minimum/side. (equal patrols)
 - o All Patrols play each other.

Night:

- Kan Jam: 2-man Teams
 - o Each Patrol can make 4 teams for bracketed competition (16 teams).
 - o Random draw for placement, though not against your own patrol 1st round.
- Card Game... Poker / Chess / Other.

Scout Competitions:

- Fire Building Night
 - o 2 people per team. As many teams as want to try.
 - o Start fire with Pre-made pile of materials.
 - o Using ferro rod as starter.
- Cooking Competition Lunch
 - o Lunch.
 - o Adults to come up with Food menu, but no recipes.
 - o Scouts to determine what to make with the food.
 - o To be judged by leaders on Presentation, Originality, Taste

TROOP GAMES SCORING:

- Team Sports Games:
 - o Win 5pts. Tie 2pts. Loss 0pts.
- Bracketed type games:
 - o 1st 10pts / 2nd 7pts / 3rd 4pts / 4th 2pts
- Fire Building
 - o Points based on completion within a time frame.
 - o 1 minute: 10 points, 2 minutes 5 points, 3 minutes 2 points.
 - o Extra points for fastest team. Bonus 5 points.
- Cooking Competition
 - o Presentation / Originality / Taste: 0-10pts each (judged by adults not cooking)
 - o 1 minute: 10 points, 2 minutes 5 points, 3 minutes 2 points.
 - Card Games / Chess. Individually 1pts per win. Goes towards team points.


TENT ASSIGNMENTS:

Tenting of scouts: Scouts may tent in their own tent or with other scouts. There will not be locations for Hamock Camping. Patrols should camp together in separate patrol areas.

CONDITIONS TO BE AWARE OF:

- HYDRATION- Remember to bring one gallon and drink plenty of water throughout the day.
