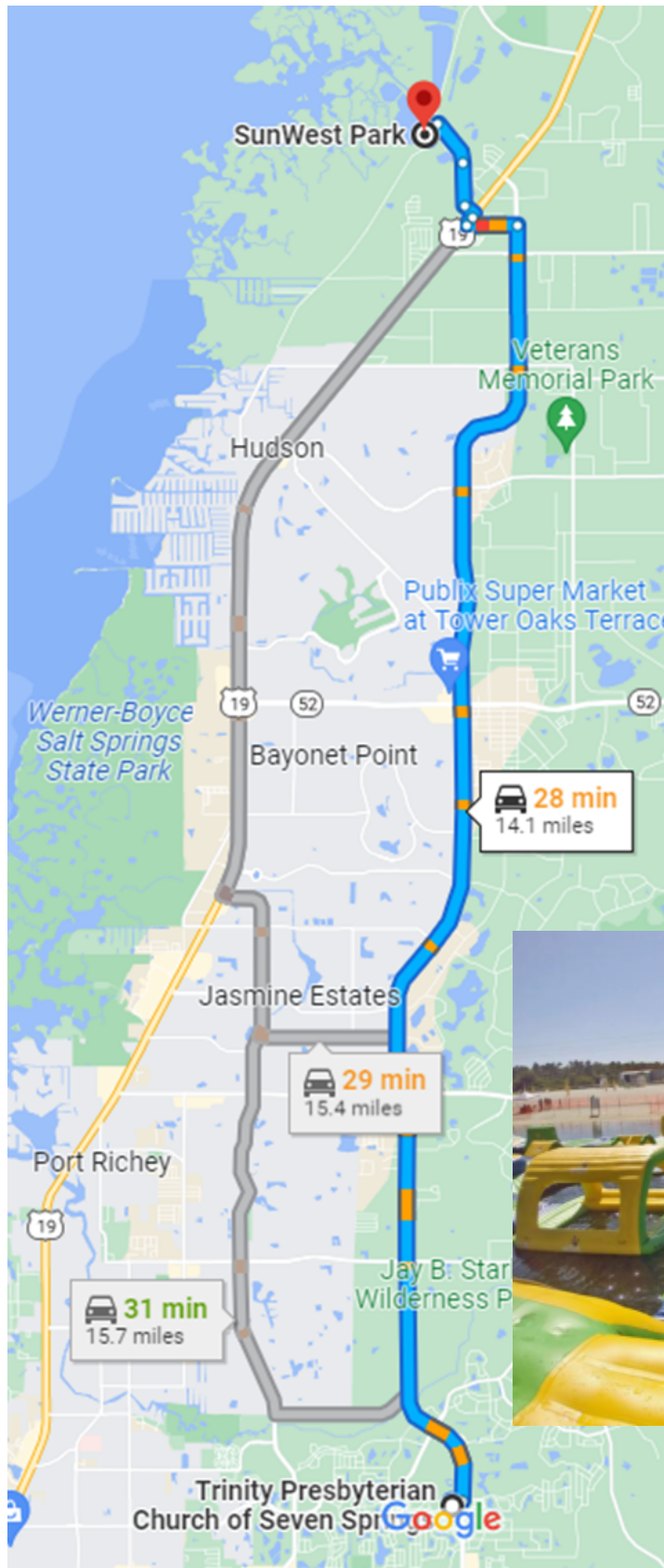

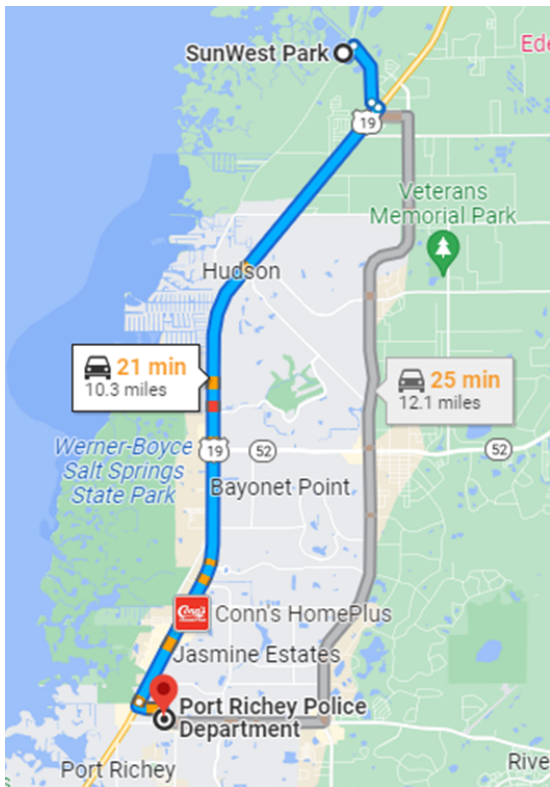
MAP FROM TRINITY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF SEVEN SPRINGS TO

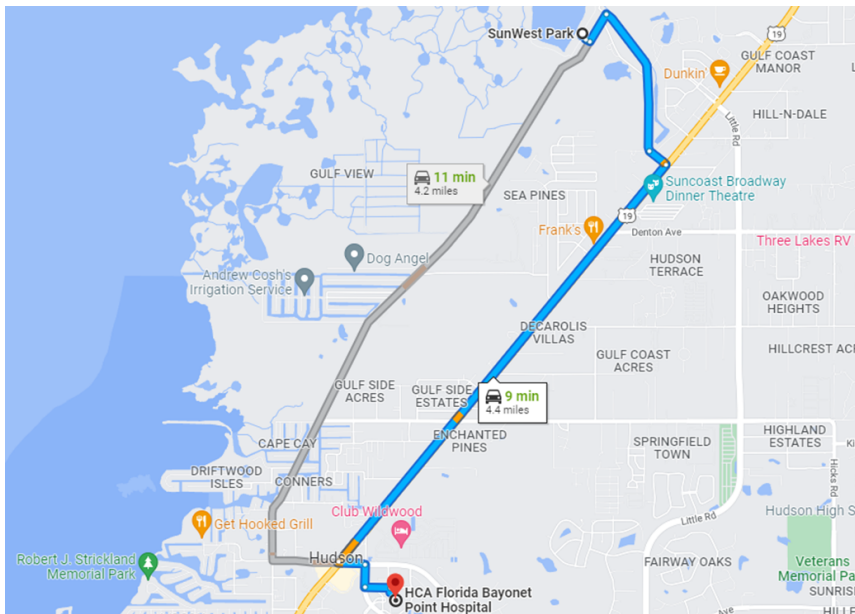

MEALS – Cook assigned meals for all scouts.

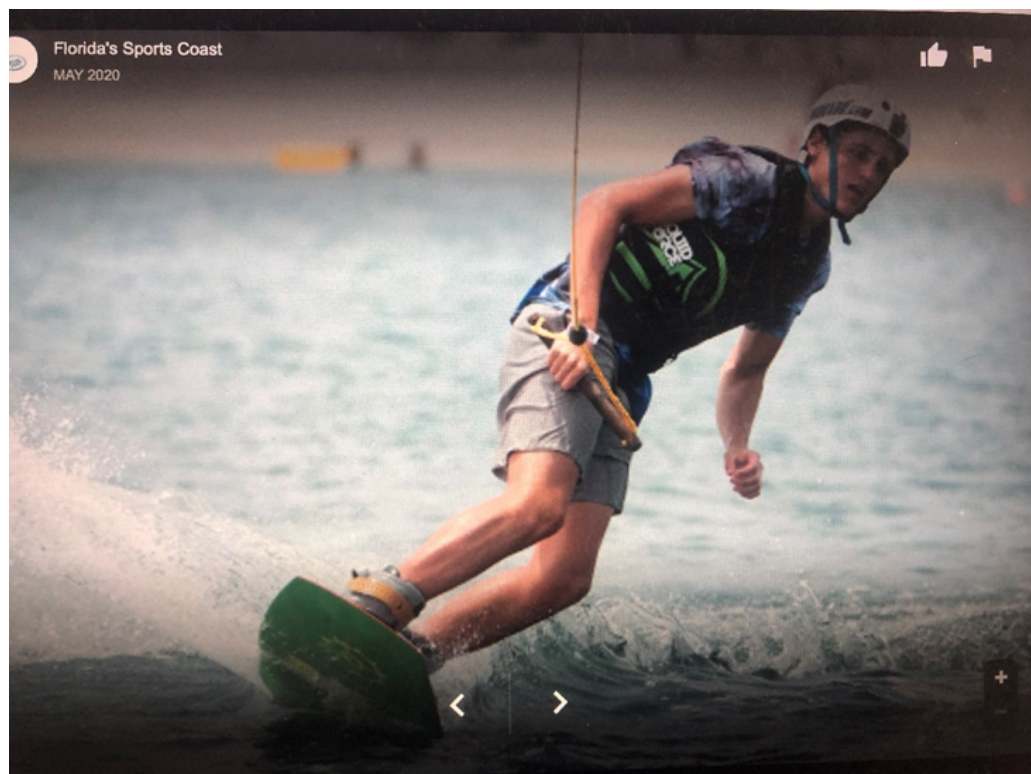
DISHES – Heat water and Clean shared dishes for the assigned meal (Everyone does their own personal dishes).

CONDITIONS TO BE AWARE OF:

- o **All** – Fire must be in fire pit.
- o **HYDRATION** - Remember to drink plenty of water throughout the day.
- o **DO NOT** approach, touch, or feed any of the wildlife. It is against the law.
- o **BUGS** – Bring bug spray, mosquito net if sensitive to insect bites.
- o **BATHROOMS** – Bathhouse is available a short (1/2 mile) walk from the campsite.
- o **WATER** – Water is available at the Bathhouse. We will also have our large water containers filled with water. And will fill them as needed.

TENT ASSIGNMENTS:

- SCOUTS MAY BRING THEIR OWN TENT, OUR USE TROOP TENTS AS AVAILABLE.
There is a large group attending, so scouts borrowing tents may need to double up.
No more than 2 years (720 calendar days) between tent buddies.

If anyone wants to work on Wilderness Survival will need to make their shelter Saturday and sleep in it Saturday night.

Note: Scouters over the age of 16 need a Florida Fishing License.

- Salt Shoreline is Free, but you still have to apply.
- Salt from boat/kayak is \$17.
- Freshwater from shore/boat/kayak is \$17.
- Best way is through the "Fish Hunt Florida" App. Keeps the digital license with you as long as you have your mobile device.
